FULL TIME Veterinary Social Work Program **The Mentorship Program** is intended for new grads or established doctors looking for a career change to Emergency Medicine. (It does not replace/substitute an internship, required for application to a residency). This program is an intensive learning opportunity, but 1st Pet emphasizes a sustainable, enjoyable, flexible working environment where work/life integration is possible.

Didactic Program: Our Program is delivered using a combination of on-site, off-site, and on-demand modalities.

• Weekly lecture series for the first 12 weeks, then monthly literature/M&M Review

• Skills labs: POCUS, RECOVER, vascular access, enteral access, flexible endoscopy, bandages and splints, extended ALS and mechanical ventilation, and cadaver labs

- Creation of educational presentations to demonstrate your understanding and mastery of key concepts to peers.

Experiential Program: Initially, receive mentored case management under the guidance of an experienced attending emergency veterinarian. After an intensive on-boarding period, escalating direct case management responsibilities are granted as you attain confidence and competence. All of our doctors have easy access to colleagues when questions arise. With independence, experienced emergency doctors and Board-Certified Specialists in Internal Medicine, Surgery and Critical Care are either on-site or a phone call away.

• All doctors have access to STAT and comprehensive in-house laboratories, point-of-care ultrasound (POCUS), & digital radiology studies interpreted by Radiologists. An 8-slice CT scanner is available at the NV location, a 64-slice CT scanner is available for use at the Chandler and Mesa locations, and a flexible endoscope system is shared by the hospitals. Vapotherm high flow oxygen systems are available at all 3 hospitals and a Pulmonetics LTV 1200 ventilator is also available.

Flexible Training

The 1st Pet Veterinary Centers' Early Career Mentorship Program is a full time position that harnesses the knowledge, energy and time of experienced emergency doctors and board-certified specialists motivated to accommodate your career goals in Emergency Practice – all with a market-leading compensation plan. The first-year salary is about \$120,000 based on anticipated progress from direct mentorship to more independence and core shift coverage following Boot Camp (12 weeks). Once you are comfortable seeing cases independently for entire shifts, additional per diem or hourly pay is available for optional coverage of open shifts or to provide on-call help during a case surge at one of the hospitals.

We offer a wide array of benefits including: health, vision, dental, disability, life and accidental death insurance; 50 hrs PTO and one week of vacation; 401K and Employee Stock Ownership Plan for retirement savings; AZ State Licensure, AVMA, PLIT, DEA, VIN, Plumb's, VetGirl memberships; Fear Free and RECOVER BLS/ALS Certification; \$3000 in continuing educational funds for outside CE; AND...no non-competes, restrictive covenants, or multi-year contract obligation. We want you to want to work here and stay for the right reasons!

Your schedule will include an equitable mix of traditional hours (weekdays) and non-traditional hours (nights, weekends, holidays). Each shift is about 12 hours, and you can expect to be scheduled on-service 36-42 hours per week (14 shifts per 28-day period). Additional time will be required for attending lectures, studying lessons and pertinent literature, creating educational content, and case/procedure preparation. Initially, you will have mentored case management under the guidance of an experienced attending veterinarian. In time, you will be permitted escalating direct case management responsibilities as you attain confidence and demonstrate competence.
